



He didn't know his shoe size because it had been so long since he got new clothes, but he did express that he really liked black shoes. So, our volunteers traced his shoe on a piece of paper to estimate his size. After looking through some pictures, he found a pair he liked. When the volunteer brought them back and handed them to him, he started to cry. He said he didn't deserve anything this nice. But if only this sweet boy knew he truly deserved this and so much more. He wanted to call his grandmother and show her his new shoes, feeling so proud of them

For some, it's just a pair of shoes, but for him, it represented being seen and the gift of kindness that made him feel valued. It was him seeing through his own eyes that he was seen and noticed. We are so blessed to be able to perform acts of kindness like this for so many children who truly deserve it and help them to see they do truly deserve it and so much more.




Human Trafficking Awareness
